#### **FESTIVAL HOW TO!**

**TENT SETUP:** Patrons can set up tents after 7:30 AM on Saturday, August 2nd. Tents up before this time will be dismantled, as it interferes with the festival's ability to prepare the grounds. Overnight camping is not allowed in Frontier Park.

**FIRES PROHIBITED:** Fires and grills are not allowed at the park.

**PETS:** Dogs and furry/scaled friends are not allowed in the park, leave the pals at home! Working service dogs are welcome.

**LAWN GAMES:** Such as corn hole, horseshoes, Kan Jam, and others take up space that can prevent others from sitting, dancing, and enjoying the day. If your setup is excessive in space, or restricting the use of the lawn, festival staff may ask you to move your setup or pack it away.

**PARKING:** On-site parking is not available. Think about carpooling, walking, cycling, or taking the festival shuttle bus to get to Frontier Park. Some parking spots around the park will be saved for accesibility parking. A placard is required.

**SHUTTLE BUS:** On Saturday, the City has kindly setup a shuttle bus from the Lincoln Park & Ride from 10:00 AM to10:00 PM. On Sunday, a private bus will make the rounds from the same spot, from 12:00 PM to10:00 PM.

**BUCKET BRIGADE:** We have a crew of volunteers in vests, with buckets collecting donations. For every \$20, you get a festival pin. Donating to the bucket bridage directly supports the Erie Blues & Jazz Festival.

**BAND MERCH:** A special tent with band merch is located in front of the main stage.

**FESTIVAL MERCH:** As a non-profit, festival merch is an important fundraiser for us. We worked with local vendors to create our wares: Leadhead Screenprinting for the koozies and shirts, Printing Concepts for printing our posters and Marijac Embroidery for the hats. Visit our merch tent to support the festival!

**FIRST AID:** Located behind the main stage.

**SHOP, EAT, AND FIND A CAUSE:** Local food, craft, and artisan vendors are located around the festival. Local non-profits and environmental organizations are also here to talk about how you can make a difference in Erie.

**TAKE CARE OF YOURSELF AND OTHERS:** Stay hydrated. Dance with your neighbors. Do what you can to make sure that you and the people around you have a experience!


